Dear Parents,

On behalf of Bradfield Cricket Club, I would like to welcome your child to Bradfield CC and provide you with some information about the cricket activities we offer. Bradfield CC provides opportunities for young people between the ages of 8 and 15 to receive coaching and competition in the Berkshire Youth Cricket League. All coaching is provided by qualified coaches under the direction of Performance Cricket.

ALLSTARS CRICKET

This season we will again be running the AllStars Cricket Programme (an ECB-led initiative aimed at introducing young children to cricket) beginning in May. This is aimed at 5-8yr olds only and will run for approx 8 weeks. There will be lots more information released over the next few weeks about this exciting initiative, so look out for the emails.

TRAINING SESSIONS

We welcome parents, carers or guardians to all training and competitions and value your support. As a family club we are keen to try and involve everyone, the coaches are all volunteers and give up their time to coach and mentor the juniors, so we would appreciate your support to help out with bar/bbq at outdoor training sessions. This would only amount to a couple of sessions per year, please contact Mike Reed or David Brown for more information.

Indoor training sessions for all age groups are held for 10 weeks at St Andrews School Sports Hall, Buckhold, Pangbourne RG8 8QA from February 1st onwards between 6.30-7.30pm for Under 9s and 11s, 7.30-8.30pm for Under 13s and 15s. Outdoor training sessions will take place on Fridays at Bradfield CC, Heath Road, Bradfield for U9s-U13s. Adults and U15s will train on Thursdays.

Berkshire Youth League age group matches are between May-July (please see website for dates/fixtures when released).

We recommend that your child wears a tracksuit/shorts and shirt with trainers at indoor sessions, with cricket boots/spikes being allowed for outdoor training sessions, they should also bring a drink to indoor training (refreshments are available from the bar during outdoor sessions).

Arrangements should be made for your child to travel to and from training sessions and matches. We would appreciate it if children can arrive promptly and are collected promptly at the end of the session. If you are going to be late picking your child up, please contact David Brown on 07769 705222 or Mike Reed on 07887 495178 and let them know.
